The paper on Wewak is intended as a trial format for subsequent papers on Madang, Port Moresby, Lae, Goroka, Mount Hagen and Rabaul. The primary aim of this work is to illustrate spatial pattern in order to indicate what patterns exist and the likely relationships between variables.

5105.00 1980 National Population Census: Research Monograph No.2 - The Mortality Situation in Papua New Guinea

The fourth in the series of the census monographs which covers information on mortality. It consists of three parts: Part I emphasizes on the "Mortality Situation" in PNG and its geographical subdivisions. It is therefore a very technical nature. A very large portion of Part II consists of reversion of working papers previously distributed. The third part (Part III) deals with abridged life tables for PNG and its four (4)

regions and twenty (20) provinces. Lifetables have been constructed for each of the geographical sectors (Rural Village, Rural Non-Village, Urban as well as all sectors combined) and by sex (males, females and total). In this monograph, little use has been made of previous results of mortality analysis based on 1971 census data.

The monograph intends to be as "user friendly" as possible and is therefore concerned with results of the fertility analysis and discussion of the results.

**5106.13 1980 National Population Census: Research Monograph No.7 -
Madang in maps: Spatial Characteristics of Census Data**

The last series of the 1980 census monographs. It covers information on spatial distribution of census characteristics in Madang. However, its primary aim is to illustrate spatial patterns in order to include what patterns exists and likely relationships between variables. Data from the 1980 census was extracted at the census unit level to major social and economic characteristics on Madang and other larger towns in the country. The papers on Madang and Wewak are intended as a trial format for subsequent papers on Port Moresby, Lae, Goroka, Mount Hagen and Rabaul.

Summarises the finding of the 1996 Papua New Guinea Demographic and Health Survey (PNGDHS). Contains details about the National Demographic and Health Survey; its objectives and contents, methods and procedures used in the collection of data. Findings are presented by range of demographic and health indicators. The report provided shows clear picture of the current level of demographic and health indicators and the likely course for the future. Very informative and indeed essential for monitoring and evaluating the performance of health and family planning programmes. The findings presented in this report represent a sub-sample of about 5,000 household from the sample of 25,000 households selected across the country. Women of ages 15-49 were the respondents. Some topics included are: household and respondents' characteristics, fertility, family planning, marriage and polygony, fertility preferences, infant and child mortality and maternal mortality, maternal and child health care, infant feeding practices and AIDS knowledge and behavior. Appendices and tables are also included.

Contains statistics compiled from passengers arrivals and departures. It provides a break down of persons arriving in PNG by purpose of journey, age, nationality and occupation and persons departing PNG by length of stay, purpose of journey and overseas address.

6202.00 1980 National Population Census: Research Monograph, No. 3 - Inter-Provincial Migration in Papua New Guinea.

Irregular; first and final issue: 1980 (1985); 1102pp; PNG/Overseas PGK6.00

The third in the series of census monographs which deals with Inter-Provincial Migration. Almost all discussions concern the citizen population only. Little references is made to migratory theory, previously PNG migration research or to sources other than the 1980 National Census, although trends evident from earlier censuses are briefly considered. The monograph is essentially descriptive and directly primarily towards planners, researchers, and interested officials in PNG.

6203.00 1980 National Population Census: Research Monograph, No. 5 – Migration and Urbanization of Papua New Guinea

Irregular; first and final issue: 1980 (1987); 138pp; PNG/Overseas PGK6.00

The fifth in the series of 1980 census monograph that presents results derived from the data collected in the 1980 National Population Census. It deals with migration and urbanization in PNG. Like it's predecessor on Inter-Provincial Migration in PNG, is directed mainly towards planners, researchers and officials in PNG and overseas who are interested in data on migration.
